Warrington Township requests a Greenways, Trails, and Recreation Program (GTRP) grant of \$113,333.00 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for the construction of Kids' Mountain, a playground for all children regardless of ability.

CKS Engineers confirmed that all public/site improvements have been satisfactorily completed by the project developer. Improvements constructed are to be privately owned/maintained by the property owner; therefore a maintenance bond will not be required for this project.

This project includes improvements at two existing sewage pumping stations. Bids will be received on June 15, 2018.
